About us

In 1997 HRIF was founded to help those in need. The focus of HRIF is on helping the most vulnerable people and groups in emergency situations all over the world. HRIF helps by sending aid, including clothing and food. We collect and sort goods in our warehouse in Weesp, the Netherlands. Once the goods are combined, we arrange transport to our local partners on the ground, who then distribute the aid.

We collect donated goods and aid from companies and organizations. Together with our local partners on the ground we assess the needs of the communities we support and distribute the required goods efficiently. Our local partners always have good knowledge of where help is most needed and have the right expertise for the distributions so that they are fair and safe. HRIF is always sensitive to local customs and authorities regarding import rules and regulations. This method of working allows us to offer targeted and rapid large-scale help.

The people who receive our help are vulnerable people and groups including children, women and the elderly in Europe, Asia, Africa and South America. HRIF focuses on shipping clothes, shoes, blankets, food, medical equipment, medicines and (hospital) beds.

When we receive a large donation of toys, we will send it to warzones and refugee camps. At first glance, it may seem that toys aren't a necessity of life but for children it is important to be able to play. However, being able to play is of vital importance for children. By playing, children begin to process the things they experienced, they learn to socialize and to communicate. Every child has the right to play. That is why we believe it so important to send toys to children who don't have any.

The impact of sending and distributing aid in emergency situations and ongoing projects is incredible. Time and again people say that this is a sign of hope in an otherwise hopeless situation.

Both our office and warehouse are in Weesp just outside of Amsterdam. We work here with a small team of employees and volunteers

Mission House / Poland

Mission House is the Coordination Centre Eastern Europe projects, for several charities under which H.R.I.F.

This Centre operates from Poland for over 30 years, by staff with long-lasting relations and contacts in amongst others Poland, Ukraine, Belarus, Russia, Moldova.

Main objectives are

- Visiting projects / teams
- Home visits to the elderly and sick
- Funding salaries for local workers
- Funding food-kitchens
- Funding social activities
- Distribution of humanitarian goods send amongst others by H.R.I.F.













Part of a report from a country manager Ukraine:

The situation with the coronavirus in Ukraine is very deplorable. The government does not have funds for the elderly, invalids, single mothers, or elderly people to support at this difficult time. Many people lost their jobs. People are left to fend for themselves without social support. Ambulances and doctors are not able to help, because there is no technical and financial support from State of Ukraine. Often the elderly, lonely and infirm people are left alone in this difficult time of the pandemic, waiting for death without help or hope

The socially unprotected categories of people who are not patients with coronavirus also suffer. Because of the quarantine, a soup kitchen in which 40 poor people ate was closed in Zaporozhye. Now it is only possible to organize the delivery of meals to homes, but this is much more expensive as it requires funds to pay the driver's salary and pay for gasoline.

In some cases, such as Garry Grigorievich, we help with funds to pay for medicines and supplies. People such as Rose, born in 1924 who worked all her life in a mine in Donetsk, now bedridden with a femoral fracture who needs help for medication and her utility bill. Aleksandra, born in 1935 who had a very difficult surgery and needs specialized food, medications and visits because she is quite lonely.
